

SHROUD TV

David Rolfe, the film director who made ‘The Silent Witness’ back in the 1970’s, and more recently ‘Shroud of Turin – Material Evidence’ (premiered on the BBC in 2008) and the official six-language film for the 2010 public exhibition (entitled simply ‘Shroud’), has launched a new project which should prove essential viewing for all interested in the cloth kept in Turin.

The actual amount of footage filmed to make a one-hour documentary far exceeds what is seen on television or the DVD, and sometimes the choice of what to leave off is very tough. There is so much that deserves to be included and yet is rarely seen – so what David has done here is take whole sections and interviews filmed for his 2008 documentary Material Evidence and make them visible in their entirety.

Already available for viewing are the full body wrapping demonstration by John Jackson and in-depth discussions of the Carbon 14 dating, the fold marks and the Sudarium of Oviedo. Among the many features to be added in the near future (and which may well be available by the time the newsletter is sent out) are full interviews with Bruno Barberis from the Centro Internazionale di Sindonologia in Turin, and Monsignor Ghiberti, also from Turin.
